The Westerly Airport Association annually awards scholarships to assist students pursuing post-secondary education toward an aviation or aerospace-related career, such as flight crew, aircraft maintenance, aeronautical or astronautical engineering, airline or airport operations and the like.

We are seeking nominations of possible candidates from teachers and guidance counselors, who are in the best position to know of the students' genuine interest and realistic expectations for success in an aviation education and career.

The ideal candidate(s) will have demonstrated commitment to the chosen course of study, evidenced by related activities. These might include such pursuits as having already taken ground and flight training, passed FAA exams, attended aviation camps, served in the Civil Air Patrol, and completed internships or work experience at airports or aviation-related businesses. WAA Scholarships are awarded based on motivation, character, academic excellence, financial need, and the recommendations of his/her teachers/guidance counselors. To be eligible, students must have permanent residence in New England, preferably southern Rhode Island and Southeastern Connecticut.

Any WAA Scholarship recipient may be considered for renewal in subsequent years, based upon academic success demonstrated in his/her transcript, along with the recommendations of professors in the student's major studies, as well as continued financial need.
